

WHO THIS IS FOR - Operators purchasing gravel directly from NANA Regional Corporation

- Identify and obtain all permits required for your material site usage. Contact the Alaska Department of Natural Resources (ADNR) Office of Project Management & Permitting (OPMP) at 907-269-8400 for assistance with determining the permits and plans required for your gravel project.
- 2. Before you mine, you must:
 - a) obtain a Material Sales Agreement (MSA) or Letter of Authorization (LOA) from NRC, and
 - b) provide NRC with copies of all permits and plans required to operate at a material site.
- 3. If you check, "not required," you must provide a specific reason why it's not required in the "If "Not Required," explainwhy" column. "Not applicable" is not a sufficient response.

This checklist is not all inclusive. It includes the most common permits and plans required for Material Sites. Your project may have additional permit and/or plan requirements. You are responsible for determining the permits you need.

All gravel users must close out the pit activity with NRC after they complete mining and/or the MSA/LOA expires. Contact NRC toarrange pit closure.
